### NEW RESOURCES OF INTEREST:

1. The Future of Children is a biannual publication of the Woodrow Wilson School of Public and International Affairs at Princeton University and the Brookings Institution. It seeks to promote effective policies and programs for children by providing policymakers, service providers, and the media with timely, objective information based on the best available research. This journal is available online through Project Muse. 2. Google Scholar, the newest offering from Google, searches for materials such as scholarly articles, peer-reviewed papers, theses, books, preprints, abstracts and technical reports from broad areas of research. While Google Scholar is freely available to anyone searching the Internet, many of the links to full text are not. Some of the content is available for UNLV users through library subscription databases. When searching on campus full text resources that are available from our subscribed databases or electronic journals will be automatically accessible. Google Scholar has been added to the Libraries proxy service. By linking to Google Scholar from the Libraries' "Find Articles and More" page

- (<http://www.library.unlv.edu/search/eralpha.php>), UNLV users can access all the subscribed materials. Use Google Scholar's "Advanced Search" to search author, publication and/or date of an article. A truly versatile tool for students and faculty!
3. Scopus—a new navigational tool providing access to the world's scientific, technical, medical and social sciences literature. Scopus is an easy way to get expert results, even for novice searchers. Integrated web and patents search and seamless links to full-text articles and other library resources make Scopus quicker, easier and more comprehensive to use. It contains 27 million records from 1966 to the present covering articles from 1400 peer-reviewed titles and is updated daily.
